Fruitful preparation for worship will include pondering our two Scripture readings: Psalm 42 and Matthew 11:28-30; listening prayerfully to The Porter's Gate Song, "In Times of Trouble," and considering the reflection questions:

What kinds of small disappointments have you experienced? How have you moved through them and been strengthened by bringing these disappointments to Jesus?
