WELCOME TO WORSHIP

THE IMPOSITION OF ASHES This custom begun in the Christian Church during the Middle Ages. The use of ashes on the first day of Lent reminds believers of their mortality and of their heavenly destiny in Jesus Christ. It is really two symbols; the ashes to remind us that we have come from the dust and shall return to the dust, and the sign of the cross to remind us of our new life in Christ. If you want to experience this Lenten tradition, please come forward, after the pastors have received the ashes. Come up the center aisle, keeping distance between you and those from different households. After you have received the ashes you may kneel at the altar rail for prayer as you wish and return down the side aisles. Whether you receive this symbol or not, put your full faith and confidence in Christ your Lord—for He came to lift you from the dust and ashes of this earth and bring you at last to live with God in heaven forever.

LENTEN OFFERING Proceeds from the Lenten Offering Envelope include in your March *Bethlehem Star* newsletter will go to support Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services (LIRS). The invasion of Ukraine by Russian President Vladimir Putin could potentially result in a massive refugee crisis, with between 1 and 5 million people displaced and seeking safety. We have already seen 500,00 people flee to Poland alone. Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Service stands in solidarity with our Ukrainian neighbors and is dedicated to supporting Ukrainian refugees and immigrants however possible. TAKE ACTION! Join us in urging the Biden administration to support Ukrainians here and abroad by:

- Providing humanitarian assistance
- Rebuilding a robust, well-resourced refugee program
- Designating Ukraine for Deferred Enforced Departure (DED) or Temporary Protected Status (TPS) to protect Ukrainians already in the U.S.
- Granting Special Student Relief (SSR) to allow eligible students from Ukraine to remain in the U.S.


