COMMUNION INSTRUCTIONS These instructions are also in the Worship Bulletin. Communion will be served continuously. Individual cups are still available for use in the pews. Please come forward in an orderly fashion to the side on which you are seated and pick up an empty cup from the communion tray if you wish to receive wine. After receiving the bread from the presiding or assisting minister (gluten free wafers and fish crackers available on request), then proceed to the side on which you are seated to receive the wine or grape juice. After receiving communion, you may kneel at the altar rail as you wish. Your empty cups may be left in the baskets on the stands as you return. If you would like to receive communion in your pew, but from the pastor rather than a pre-filled cup, just let the ushers know. The presiding minister will say the invitation to communion, which will include the words of distribution, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." Then you may consume Christ's body and blood immediately if you have chosen a prefilled communion wafer and cup.
