LYONS ELEMENTARY WINTER CLOTHING PROJECT

This School is in need of winter clothing donations. The Staff discreetly gives these items out to children who need them throughout the winter months. Boots, snow pants and waterproof gloves are desperately needed to keep children warm and dry and able to enjoy winter on the playground. These items are expensive enough that purchasing them can be unattainable for families with limited income. Waterproof is the key for the gloves – cloth ones will be soaked after one recess period, take too long to dry, and don't keep kids' hands warm enough. While new is best for boots and snow pants, gently used will be fine for those items if they are clean and in good shape. A collection area will be set up at church November 3, so you can bring your stuff in. We have an opportunity to make a real difference in the lives of our local children! I hope you will consider supporting this project. Shari Martinez, the school secretary, shared with me their specific needs for this year:

- Waterproof gloves or mittens preferably not pink or purple.
- Boots, sizes 12, 13, 1 and 2 preferably not pink or purple, and not indoor fashion boots.
- Snow pants, sizes 8, 10, 12 and 14 preferably not pink or purple.
