CONGREGATIONAL MEETING Today we will meet at 11:30, after the 10:00 service of worship to review and approve the proposed 2023 Budget, to approve the Board Members, and to elect voting members for this year's Synod Assembly, May 7-9, in Mt. Pleasant.

ADULT FORUM We have begun a deep dive into Prayer. We will see how the Spirit moves us, but we are likely to continue this focus all through the Sundays after Epiphany as we will be praying in the Light of Christ. We will begin working through a process to help us determine our *Spiritual Type*, which can point us toward prayer practices that we may find meaningful or even prayer practices that might challenge us.
